A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Contract No. CW100309 with The National Center for Children and Families, and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto, to provide Permanent Supportive Housing III program case management services to residents experiencing homelessness, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the human care agreement and modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Contract No. CW100309 with The National Center for Children and Families Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and consistent with the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Contract No. CW100309 with The National Center for Children and Families, and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto, to provide Permanent Supportive Housing III program case management services to residents experiencing homelessness and authorizes payment in the total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$2,070,892.51, for

35 the goods and services received and to be received under the human care agreement and
36 modifications.

43 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
44 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
45 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
46 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
47 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
