A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 3 and 4 to Contract No. CW93294 with IMA Professional Services of DC, PC to conduct medical record reviews and consultative exams for claimants that are either currently receiving Social Security Supplemental Security Income or applying for a disability determination with the Social Security Administration, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW93294 with IMA Professional Services of DC, PC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of Section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 3 and 4 to Contract No. CW93294 with IMA Professional Services of DC, PC to conduct medical record reviews and consultative exams for claimants that are either currently receiving Social Security Supplemental Security Income or applying for a disability determination with the Social Security

36 the goods and services received and to be received under the contract for the period from
37 March 1, 2023 through February 29, 2024.
