On Friday, June 16, 2023, Councilmember Anita Bonds will hold a public roundtable on “Mistreatment of Workers at District of Columbia Subsidized Developments and Worker Protections”. The roundtable will be held on Friday, June 16, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast.

The stated purpose of this roundtable is to discuss recent instances of worker mistreatment in the District of Columbia, especially in city-subsidized developments. Moreover, the stated purpose of this roundtable is to understand existing employee rights and explore ways to bolster employment protections for workers in their endeavor to unionize within the District of Columbia.

Oral testimony will be limited to 5 minutes for those testifying on behalf of an organization and 3 minutes for those testifying on behalf of themselves.
