On Friday, June 16, 2023, Councilmember Anita Bonds will hold a public roundtable to discuss the Office of Youth Programs within the Department of Employment Services (DOES). The roundtable will be held on Friday, June 16, 2023, at 11:00 AM in-person and virtually via Zoom.

This roundtable is limited to government witnesses only. The subject of the roundtable is regarding the Office of Youth Programs (OYP). OYP develops and administers workforce development programs for District youth ages 14-24. It provides occupational skills training, work experience, academic enrichment and life skills training to facilitate the development of work habits and skills that are essential for success in the workplace. The roundtable will examine the effectiveness of these programs, as well as identify areas in need of improvement.

Each witness will receive an individual Zoom invitation for the hearing in a separate e-mail. Witnesses are encouraged to submit an electronic version of their testimony to ceal@dccouncil.gov. Oral testimony will be limited to 5 minutes for those testifying on behalf of an organization and 3 minutes for those testifying on behalf of themselves.
