

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, the need to designate Good Hope Road, SE, between Anacostia Drive, SE, and Alabama Avenue, SE, as Marion Barry Avenue, SE; to symbolically designate Marion Barry Avenue, SE, between the intersection of Naylor Road, SE, and 25th Street, SE, and Alabama Avenue, SE, as Good Hope Way; and to require the District to reissue certain documents to individuals and entities with new addresses on Marion Barry Avenue, SE.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Marion Barry Avenue Designation Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) On May 2, 2023, the Council adopted the Marion Barry Avenue Designation Emergency Act of 2023, enacted June 2, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-112; 69 DCR 7938) which expires on August 22, 2023.

(b) On May 5, 2023, the Marion Barry Avenue Designation Act of 2023 was enacted (“permanent act”), which is pending congressional review. The act has an applicability date of July 1, 2023.

(c) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the permanent measure.

33 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
34 in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances, making it necessary that the Marion
35 Barry Avenue Designation Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2023 be adopted
36 after a single reading.

37 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
