33	238), is amended as follows:
34	(a) Section 202(e)(1) is amended by striking the phrase "on an annual basis thereafter"
35	and inserting the phrase "once per Council Period thereafter, provided that applicable laws may
36	require more frequent training for certain individuals" in its place.
37	(b) Section 306(b) is amended by adding a new paragraph (5) to read as follows;

38	(5) A request for a budget modification for Fiscal Year 2023 grant funds that is
39	either submitted by the University of the District of Columbia, or identified by the Chief
40	Financial Officer as funds received as part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Pub. L.
41	117-58) or the Inflation Reduction Act (Pub. L. 117-169), may be transmitted to the Secretary
