A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 10 and 11 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 10 and 11 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 10 and 11 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing (“Contract”) for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

(b) UMC determined that exercising Option Year 2 of the Contract was necessary due to the ongoing need for nurses in the emergency department, ICU, and telemetry unit.

37 Partial Option Year 2, Modification 10, was fully executed on December 13, 2022, with a
38 value of \$925,000.00 for the period of December 10, 2022 through February 7, 2023.

39 (c) Proposed Modification 11 for an additional \$4,200,000.00 through the
40 remainder of the option year (February 8, 2023 – December 9, 2023), is necessary to
41 allow continued use of this Contract. If approved, the combined 12-month retroactive
42 value of Option Year 2 would be \$5,125,000.00 for the period of December 10, 2022 –
43 December 9, 2023. This would have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-
44 month period; therefore, Council approval is necessary.

45 (d) Without this approval, Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. cannot be
46 paid for these critical services to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

47 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
48 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification Nos. 10 and
49 11 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Approval and
50 Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023, be adopted after a single reading.

51 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
