A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 to Contract No. CW62890 with PFC Associates, LLC to provide occupational and ancillary healthcare services at the Police and Fire Clinic, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 to Contract No. CW62890 with PFC Associates, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 to Contract No. CW62890 with PFC Associates, LLC to provide occupational and ancillary healthcare services at the Police and Fire Clinic, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$18,880,560.20 for the goods and services received and to be received for the

34 period from August 22, 2022 through August 21, 2023, and the not-to-exceed amount of
35 \$19,755,480.84 for the period from August 22, 2023 through August 21, 2024.

43 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
44 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
45 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
46 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
