A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve multiyear Contract No. DCAM-21-NC-RFQ-0001E PPA-23-01 with NEO, LLC to provide solar energy generation systems at (i) Banneker High school, (ii) John Lewis Elementary School and (iii) Takoma Aquatic Center.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DCAM-21-NC-RFQ-0001E PPA-23-01 with NEO, LLC Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2 (a) The Department of General Services proposes to enter into a multiyear contract with NEO, LLC to provide solar energy generation systems at (i) Banneker High school, (ii) John Lewis Elementary School and (iii) Takoma Aquatic Center.

(b) The not-to-exceed amount of this multiyear contract with NEO, LLC is \$0/KWH for a twenty-year period of performance from November 21, 2022, to November 20, 2042.

(c) Approval is necessary to allow the District to receive the benefit of reducing the Districts energy consumption from existing traditional energy sources and lowering the overall energy cost over the subsequent twenty-year period.

34 (d) These critical services can only be obtained through an award of a multiyear
35 Power Purchase Agreement contract with NEO, LLC.

36 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
37 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
38 “Contract No. DCAM-21-NC-RFQ-0001E PPA-23-01 with NEO, LLC Emergency
39 Approval Resolution of 2023” be adopted after a single reading.
