23	Sec. 2. (a) The Inspector General for the District of Columbia shall hire and direct
24	independent counsel to:
25	(1) Review investigations by the Mayor of complaints of sexual harassment and
26	violations of Mayor's Order 2017-313, effective December 18, 2017 against the Deputy Mayor
27	for Planning and Economic Development and Chief of Staff to the Mayor as of January 1, 2023;
28	(2) Investigate other findings and items outside of the scope of prior
29	investigations pursuant to paragraph (1), including hiring and promotion practices, workplace
30	culture, and allegations of retaliation against complainants; and,
31	(3) Review and make recommendations on sexual harassment complaint and
32	investigation procedures for District government.

33 (b) The Inspector General shall provide findings to the Mayor and Council no later than
34 60 days after the effective date of this act.

(c) Independent counsel hired by the Inspector General pursuant to subsection (a) of this
 section shall have experience in confidentiality and sexual harassment law, including litigation
 and mediation.

38 (d) Any subsequent formal or informal complaints received related to individuals and
 39 systems investigated pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall be investigated by

40 independent counsel under the direction of the Inspector General.
