18	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to
19	continue authorization for eligibility requirements and supports provided by the Office of
20	Migrant Services and for immigrant residents accessing homeless services.
21	DEGOLVED DV THE COUNCIL OF THE DIGTRICT OF COLUMPIA THAT
22	RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23	resolution may be cited as the "Migrant Services and Supports Extension Congressional Review
24	Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023".
25	Sec. 2. (a) An unprecedented influx of migrants, totaling over 10,000 individuals, have
26	arrived in Washington, DC from Texas and Arizona on over 300 buses since October 6, 2022.
27	(b) The challenges faced by these migrants necessitate immediate attention and
20	
28	comprehensive support that extends beyond the capabilities of our esteemed Non-Governmental
29	Organization (NGO) partners alone, who have expressed limitations in terms of staffing,
30	resources, and logistics.
31	(c) To address the needs, the Council enacted the Migrant Services and Supports
32	Temporary Act of 2022 on October 4, 2022, which expired on August 3rd, 2023.

33 (d) In light of the expiration of the October 2022 Temporary Act, on September 19th, 34 2023, the Council passed, at second reading, a subsequent temporary measure, the Migrant 35 Services and Supports Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2023. 36 (e) The Migrant Services and Supports Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2023 37 was accompanied by the Migrant Services and Supports Extension Emergency Amendment Act 38 of 2023, which expires on October 25, 2023. 39 (f) Given the pending Mayoral review and the 30-day congressional review of the 40 Migrant Services and Supports Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2023, coupled with the 41 impending expiration of the prior emergency on October 25th, 2023, it is crucial to enact this 42 emergency measure to ensure there is no inadvertent disruption in the provision of services and 43 support to migrants transported to the District. 44 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances 45 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the 46 Migrant Services and Supports Extension Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 47 2023 should be adopted after a single reading. 48 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
