Sec. 2. Section 7(b)(4)(B) of the	e Homeless Services Reform Act, effective October 22,
2005 (D.C. Law 16-35; D.C. Official C	Code § 4–753.01(b)(4)(B)), is amended as follows:
(a) The existing text is designat	ed as sub-subparagraph (i).
(b) New sub-subparagraphs (ii)	and (iii) are added to read as follows:
"(ii) The	Department of Human Services, or the Department's
designee, shall consider requests for Fa	amily Re-Housing Stabilization Program (FRSP)
assistance extending past 12 months if:	
٠٠((I) There is funding available within FRSP;
٠٠((II) The participant has requested an extension in writing;
۰۰((III) The participant has made a good faith effort towards
the achievement of goals set forth in ar	n individualized plan with the aim of a targeted

Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
