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14 To amend, on emergency basis, due to congressional review, the Homeless Services Reform Act
15 to establish grounds for an extension to the Family Re-Housing Stabilization Program
16 (FRSP), whereby the Department or its designee will thoroughly consider the totality of
17 the participant's circumstances, including their progress and eligibility for affordable
18 housing.

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21 Act may be cited as the “Family Re-Housing Stabilization Program Protection Congressional
22 Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023”.

23 Sec. 2. Section 7(b)(4)(B) of the Homeless Services Reform Act, effective October 22,
24 2005 (D.C. Law 16-35; D.C. Official Code § 4-753.01(b)(4)(B)), is amended as follows:

25 (a) The existing text is designated as sub-subparagraph (i).

26 (b) New sub-subparagraphs (ii) and (iii) are added to read as follows:

27 “(ii) The Department of Human Services, or the Department’s
28 designee, shall consider requests for Family Re-Housing Stabilization Program (FRSP)
29 assistance extending past 12 months if:

30 “(I) There is funding available within FRSP;

31 “(II) The participant has requested an extension in writing;

32 “(III) The participant has made a good faith effort towards
33 the achievement of goals set forth in an individualized plan with the aim of a targeted

34 progression towards exit from the supports of FRSP, as observed by the Service Provider at
35 consistent intervals, but cannot yet sustain housing stability independently of the program; and

36 “(IV) The participant has not yet been approved for
37 permanently affordable housing.

38 “(iii) When making a determination of whether to grant a
39 participant in FRSP an extension beyond 12 months, the Department or Department's designee
40 shall:

41 “(I) Consider the totality of the circumstances; and

42 “(II) Grant extensions of time in increments not greater
43 than 6 months, with regular formal reviews every 3 months to ensure that participants are given
44 the support necessary to exit the program with stable housing.”

45 “(iv) If a requested extension of FRSP assistance by a participant is
46 denied, the participant shall be given 30 days written notice prior to the final subsidy payment
47 explicitly setting forth the reason for the denial of additional assistance and inform the
48 participant that:

49 “(I) The FRSP participant has a right to appeal the
50 determination through a fair hearing and administrative review, including deadlines for
51 requesting an appeal; and

52 “(II) The FRSP participant has a right to continuation of
53 FRSP services pending the outcome of any fair hearing requested within 15 days of receipt of
54 written notice of a termination”.

55 Sec. 3. Applicability

56 This act shall apply as of July 31, 2023.

57 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

58 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
59 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
60 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

61 Sec. 5. Effective date.

62 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
63 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
64 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
65 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
66 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
