23	Sec. 2. (a) On June 6, 2023, the Council passed the Office of Administrative Hearings
24	Jurisdiction Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, effective June 27, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-138; 70
25	DCR 9069) ("emergency act"), which expires on September 25, 2023.
26	(b) On June 20, 2023, the Council passed the Office of Administrative Hearings
27	Jurisdiction Temporary Amendment Act of 2023, enacted on July 10, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-158; 70
28	DCR 9691) ("temporary act"), which is undergoing congressional review and has a projected law
29	date of October 4, 2023.
30	(c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
31	expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Office of Administrative Hearings Jurisdiction Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023 be adopted after a single reading.
