A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Contract No. CW105986 with Axar Management, LLC d/b/a Quality Inn & Suites, and Modification Nos. 1 and 2 thereto, to provide emergency accommodations to migrant families arriving from the Arizona-Mexico and Texas-Mexico borders, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract and modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Contract No. CW105986 with Axar Management, LLC d/b/a Quality Inn & Suites Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the provisions of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.01 *et seq.*), or any other provision of law, the Council approves Contract No. CW105986 with Axar Management, LLC d/b/a Quality Inn & Suites, and Modification Nos. 1 and 2 thereto, to provide emergency accommodations to migrant families arriving from the Arizona-Mexico and Texas-Mexico borders, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount

35 of \$2,048,799 for the goods and services received from February 15, 2023 through June
36 30, 2023, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$7,714,205.60 for
37 goods and services received and to be received during the period July 1, 2023 through
38 June 30, 2024.

46 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
47 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
48 Columbia in Section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
49 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
