Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable before the Committee of the Whole in relation to **PR 25-486**, the "Board of Zoning Adjustment Carl Blake Confirmation Resolution of 2023." The roundtable will be held at **12:30 p.m.** (or immediately following the preceding hearing) on Tuesday, October 31, 2023.

The stated purpose of **PR 25-486** is to confirm the re-appointment of Carl Blake to the Board of Zoning Adjustment. The Board of Zoning Adjustment is an independent, quasi-judicial body with the ability to grant relief from the strict application of the District's zoning regulations in the form of variances, to grant special exceptions where authorized under the Zoning Regulations, and to hear appeals from actions taken by the Zoning Administrator of the Department of Buildings. The purpose of this roundtable is to receive testimony from government and public witnesses as to the fitness of this nominee for reappointment to the Commission.
