On Thursday, November 9, 2023, Councilmember Brianne K. Nadeau, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Works and Operations, will convene a public roundtable to consider Proposed Resolution 25-0280, the “Department of For-Hire Vehicles Melinda Bolling Confirmation Resolution of 2023” and Proposed Resolution 25-0420, the “Director of the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection Tiffany Crowe Confirmation Resolution of 2023.” The roundtable will begin at 10:00 a.m.

Proposed Resolution 25-0280, the “Department of For-Hire Vehicles Melinda Bolling Confirmation Resolution of 2023,” would confirm the appointment of Acting Director Melinda Bolling as Director of the Department of For-Hire Vehicles.

Proposed Resolution 25-0420, the “Director of the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection Tiffany Crowe Confirmation Resolution of 2023,” would confirm the appointment of

Acting Director Tiffany Crowe as Director of the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection.

The roundtable will have a hybrid format, with the government appearing in person, and public witnesses appearing virtually via the Zoom platform. Those who wish to testify must register using the Council's Hearing Management System at <https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings> by **12 p.m. on Wednesday, November 8, 2023**. Representatives of organizations will be allowed a maximum of five minutes for oral testimony, and individuals (and any subsequent representatives of the same organizations) will be allowed a maximum of three minutes. Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding by emailing [publicworks@dccouncil.gov](mailto:publicworks@dccouncil.gov). We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests. Witnesses will receive instructions on how to participate by Zoom prior to the hearing. Public witnesses will participate virtually via the Internet on the Zoom Video Conference platform. Testimony will be publicly accessible upon Committee review. If you are unable to testify at the hearing, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record. Statements for the record should be submitted through the Hearing Management System.
