Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public hearing of the Committee of the Whole on the topic of Academic Achievement in the District. The hearing will be held on **Wednesday**, **December 6, 2023, at 1:00 p.m.**

The stated purpose of this hearing is to examine academic achievement in the District of Columbia Public School (DCPS) and the District's Public Charter School (DCPCS) sectors. Specifically, this oversight hearing will focus on DCPS's and DCPCS's performance, as well as their plans for educational growth, following the release of the first Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) assessment and growth scores the District has administered since the start of the pandemic. These results continue to represent indicators of learning loss from the COVID-19 pandemic, but also shine light on areas of opportunity for all District schools. This hearing is an opportunity to discuss steps the District government is taking to improve literacy and numeracy and improve academic performance overall. The Committee has held a hearing on this matter annually.

Testimony is limited to four minutes.
