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22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23	act may be cited as the "Let Our Vows Endure Emergency Amendment Act of 2023".
24	Sec. 2. Chapter Forty-Three of An Act To establish a code of law for the District of
25	Columbia, approved March 3, 1901 (31 Stat. 1391; D.C. Official Code § 46-401 et seq.), is
26	amended as follows:
27	(a) Section 1288(a)(4) (D.C. Official Code § 46-406(a)(4)) is amended by striking the
28	phrase "authorized by the Clerk" and inserting the phrase "authorized by the Mayor or the Clerk"
29	in its place.
30	(b) Section 1291 (D.C. Official Code § 46-410) is amended as follows:
31	(1) The section heading is amended to read as follows:
32	"Sec. 1291. Duty of the Mayor or Clerk.".
33	(2) The text is amended by striking the phrase "the Clerk" both times it appears
34	and inserting the phrase "the Mayor or the Clerk" in its place.

35	(c) Section 1292 (D.C. Official Code § 46-411) is amended by striking the word "Clerk"
36	wherever it appears and inserting the phrase "Mayor or Clerk" in its place.
37	(d) Section 1293 (D.C. Official Code § 46-412) is amended as follows:
38	(1) The existing text is designated as subsection (a).
39	(2) The newly designated subsection (a) is amended by striking the phrase
40	"following form:" and inserting the phrase "following form (except when such a license is issued
41	by the Mayor, in which case a form consistent with the provisions of subsection (b) of this
42	section shall be used):" in its place.
43	(3) A new subsection (b) is added to read as follows:
44	"(b)(1) The Mayor shall create a form for a license to perform a marriage ceremony that

47	Columbia", "Court", "Clerk", "Assistant Clerk", and "Clerk of the Superior Court of the District
48	of Columbia" with appropriate references to the Mayor or to an office or officer within the

50	require that the license be returned to one or either of:
51	"(A) The Clerk's Office of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia;

82	to the Clerk of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia a true and accurate copy of the

85	maintained and certified by the Clerk, shall be competent evidence of the marriage.".
86	(f) A new section 1297a is added to read as follows:
87	"Sec. 1297a. Applicability of authority of Mayor to issue marriage licenses.
88	"The authority of the Mayor under this chapter to issue marriage licenses and authorize
89	officiants shall apply only during a period of time when the Clerk of the Superior Court of the
90	District of Columbia is not issuing marriage licenses because of a total or partial federal
91	government shutdown.".

97	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
98	Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect no longer than 90
99	days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a)
100	of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C.
101	Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
