I request that the following congressional review emergencies be agendized for the December 5, 2023 Legislative Meeting:

- Prioritizing Public Safety Second Congressional Review Emergency Declaration **Resolution of 2023**
- Prioritizing Public Safety Second Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023

On October 3, 2023, the Council passed the Prioritizing Public Safety Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, which expires on January 14, 2024. On September 19, 2023, the Council passed the Prioritizing Public Safety Temporary Amendment Act of 2023, which has a projected law date of February 6, 2024. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the first congressional review emergency and the effective date of the temporary act.

- CJCC Data Collection Technical Correction Congressional Review Emergency **Declaration Resolution of 2023**
- CJCC Data Collection Technical Correction Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023

On October 3, the Council passed the CJCC Data Collection Technical Correction Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, which expires on January 29, 2024. On November 7, 2023, the Council passed the CJCC Data Collection Technical Correction Temporary Amendment Act of 2023, which does not yet have a projected law date. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the first congressional review emergency and the effective date of the temporary act.
