A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification 1 to Contract No. NFPHC-HL-23-C between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), for the provision to provide Inpatient Hospitalists Services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification 1 to Contract No. NFPHC-HL-23-C between the Not-for Profit Hospital Corporation and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”) Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification 1 to Contract No. NFPHC-HL-23-C (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), for the provision to provide Inpatient Hospitalists services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

38 (b) The Council approved the base year on December 6, 2022 as A24-719.

39 (c) Despite a timely start to negotiations, reaching mutual agreement took longer
40 than expected – a frequent experience for UMC as the closure nears. To avoid a
41 disruption in the provision of these patient care services, proposed Modification 1 is
42 being submitted retroactively.

43 (d) If proposed Modification 1 to Contract No. NFPHC-HL-23-C is approved,
44 the exercise of option year 1 (October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2024) for \$5,978,204.84
45 would have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month period, and
46 therefore Council approval is necessary.

47 (e) Without this approval, George Washington University Medical Faculty
48 Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”) cannot be paid for these critical services provided and to
49 be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

50 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
51 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification 1 to Contract
52 No. NFPHC-HL-23-C between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and George
53 Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”) Approval and
54 Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, be adopted after a single
55 reading.

56 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
