

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to amend the Department of Transportation Establishment Act of 2002 to authorize the Director to make grants of more than \$1 million to the National Park Service for certain projects in the Buzzard Point neighborhood.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Buzzard Point Park and Trails National Park Service Grant Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) On September 19, 2023, the Council passed the Buzzard Point Park and Trails National Park Service Grant Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, effective October 12, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-254; 70 DCR 13843) (“emergency act”), which will expire on January 10, 2024.

(b) On October 3, 2023, the Council passed the Buzzard Point Park and Trails National Park Service Grant Temporary Amendment Act of 2023, enacted on October 26, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-264; 70 DCR 14452) (“temporary act”), which is projected to become law on January 17, 2024.

(c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

30 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute
31 emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Buzzard Point Park and Trails National
32 Park Service Grant Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023 be adopted after
33 a single reading.

34 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
