A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modifications 9 and 10 to Contract No. NFPHCNUR-19-C-003 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”) and Contemporary Nursing Solutions Inc., for the provision for specialty and non-specialty temporary assignment nurses, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications 9 and 10 to Contract No. NFPHCNUR-19-C-003 between Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Contemporary Nursing Solutions Inc., Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modifications 9 and 10 to Contract No. NFPHCNUR-19-C-003 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Contemporary Nursing Solutions

37 Inc., for the provision for specialty and non-specialty temporary assignment nurses, and  
38 authorizes payment for the services received and to be received under these Contracts and  
39 payments in the amount of (1) \$1,500,000.00 for proposed Modification 9, bringing the  
40 Option Year 3 Total to \$3,100,000, and (2) \$3,000,000.00 for proposed Modification 10,  
41 exercising Option Year 4.

47 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
48 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no  
49 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of  
50 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
51 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).

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
