15	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
16	to amend Appendix N of Title 12-A of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations
17	by ratifying and adopting certain sign regulations previously issued by the Chairperson of
18	the Construction Codes Coordinating Board, the Director of the Department of Consumer
19	and Regulatory Affairs, and the City Administrator, amend An Act To regulate the
20	erection, hanging, placing, painting, display, and maintenance of outdoor signs and other
21 22	forms of exterior advertising within the District of Columbia, the Construction Codes Approval and Amendments Act of 1986, and the Sign Regulation Authorization
23	Amendment Act of 2012 to clarify the rulemaking process for sign regulations, and
24	clarify the prohibition on off-premises advertising in Appendix N of Title 12-A of the
25	District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

27	RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
28	resolution may be cited as the "Sign Regulations Second Congressional Review Emergency
29	Declaration Resolution of 2023".
30	Sec. 2. (a) On September 19, 2023, the Council unanimously approved the "Sign
31	Regulation Emergency Amendment Act of 2023." The Emergency Act became law on October
32	5, 2023, and is scheduled to expire on January 3, 2024.
33	(b) On September 19, 2023, the Council unanimously approved the "Sign Regulations
34	Temporary Amendment Act of 2023." The Temporary Act was transmitted to Congress on
35	November 6, 2023, and has a projected law date January 17, 2024.

36	(c) In order to address the imminent gap in the law between the expiration of the
37	Emergency Act and the effective date of the Temporary Act, it is necessary to approve
38	congressional review emergency legislation.
39	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
40	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Sign
41	Regulation Second Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2023 be adopted after
12	a single reading.
13	Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
