Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable of the Committee of the Whole on PR25-569, “Collective Bargaining Agreement between the University of the District of Columbia and the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) Local 500, CtW Approval Resolution of 2023”. The hearing will be held on **Monday, January 8, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.**

The stated purpose of the roundtable is to receive testimony from witnesses regarding the negotiated collective bargaining agreement between the University of the District of Columbia and the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) Local 500, CtW. This roundtable will serve as an opportunity for the Committee to hear from constituents and others with regard to the soundness of the contract between the aforementioned parties.

Those who wish to testify must register using the Council’s Hearing Management System at <https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings> by **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 4, 2024. Testimony is limited to four minutes.** Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding by emailing cow@dccouncil.gov. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although alternatives may be offered. Requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled. Witnesses will receive instructions on how to participate by Zoom prior to the hearing. Public witnesses will participate virtually via the Internet on the Zoom Video Conference platform. Testimony should be submitted through the Council’s Hearing Management System (<https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings>) in advance of the hearing. Testimony will be publicly accessible upon Committee review. If you are unable to testify at the hearing, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record. Statements for the record should be submitted through the Hearing Management System or left by voicemail by calling (202) 430-6948 (up to 3 minutes which will be transcribed). The record will close at 5:00 pm on Tuesday, January 9, 2024.
