On Wednesday, January 10, 2024, Councilmember Kenyan R. McDuffie, Chairperson of the Committee on Business and Economic Development will hold an oversight roundtable on the future of Downtown and District's commitments and opportunities regarding the Capital One Arena and the Entertainment and Sports Arena. This roundtable is limited to invited witnesses.

On December 13, 2023, Monumental Sports and Entertainment (Monumental) announced plans to move its global headquarters and the Washington Capitals and Wizards franchises out of Capital One Arena in 2028. Monumental's announcement also made reference to other ideas to modify their existing commitments for Capital One Arena and the Entertainment and Sports Arena. This roundtable will clarify the District's understanding of those existing commitments and the options the Executive will explore for redeveloping Gallery Place/Chinatown/Penn Quarter if the Capitals and Wizards leave the District in 2028.
