

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to amend the University of the District of Columbia the University of the District of Columbia Expansion Act of 2010 to limit the University of the District of Columbia’s permitted use of the Patricia R. Harris Facility.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Clarification of UDC PR Harris Exclusive Use Repeal Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024”.

Sec. 2. (a) On October 3, 2023, the Council adopted the Clarification of UDC PR Harris Exclusive Use Repeal Emergency Amendment Act of 2023, enacted November 3, 2023 (D.C. Act 25-294; 70 DCR 14522) which expires on January 29, 2024.

(b) On November 7, 2023, the Council adopted the Clarification of UDC PR Harris Exclusive Use Repeal Temporary Amendment Act of 2023 on second reading (D.C. Act 25-315; 70 DCR 15474) (“temporary act”), which was transmitted to Congress on December 4, 2023 with a projected law date of February 7, 2024.

(c) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary measure.

35           Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances in  
36 section 2 constitute emergency circumstances, making it necessary that the Clarification of UDC  
37 PR Harris Exclusive Use Repeal Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2024 be  
38 adopted after a single reading.

39           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
