A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. M01, M02, and M03 to Contract No. DCAM-23-NC-RFP-0009G with Superior Services & Associates, Inc. to provide citywide comprehensive janitorial and related supplemental services, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. M01, M02, and M03 to Contract No. DCAM-23-NC-RFP-0009G with Superior Services & Associates, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202(a) of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02(a)), the Council approves Modification Nos. M01, M02, and M03 to Contract No. DCAM-23-NC-RFP-0009G with Superior Services & Associates, Inc. to provide citywide comprehensive janitorial and related supplemental services and authorizes payment in the amount of \$1,735,972 for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.
