9	Sec. 2. Section 47-4406 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows:
10	by adding a new subsection (e-3) to read as follows:
11	"(e-3) The Office of Tax and Revenue may furnish, upon request of the Department of
12	Licensing and Consumer Protection, information necessary to implement the street vending
13	amnesty program established in Section 9c of the Vending Regulation Act of 2009, Effective
14	October 22, 2009 (D.C. Law 18-71, D.C. Official Code § 37-131.08c)."

16	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
17	statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
18	October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
