## A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, Section 47-4406 of the District of Columbia Official Code to clarify that the Office of Tax and Revenue may furnish tax information to the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection, for the purposes of implementing the Street Vending Amnesty Program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Street Vending Amnesty Program Facilitation Emergency Amendment Act of 2023".

Sec. 2. Section 47-4406 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows: by adding a new subsection (e-3) to read as follows:
"(e-3) The Office of Tax and Revenue may furnish, upon request of the Department of
Licensing and Consumer Protection, information necessary to implement the street vending amnesty program established in Section 9c of the Vending Regulation Act of 2009, Effective October 22, 2009 (D.C. Law 18-71, D.C. Official Code § 37-131.08c)." Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.
(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
