A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification No. 12 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification No. 12 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification No. 12 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing (“Contract”) for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

(b) UMC determined that exercising Option Year 3 of the Contract was necessary due to the ongoing need for nurses in the emergency department, ICU, and telemetry unit.

37 (c) Proposed Modification 12 seeks retroactive approval to exercise Option year 3
38 (December 10, 2023 – December 9, 2024) for the amount of \$3,000,000.00. This would
39 have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month period; therefore, Council
40 approval is necessary.

41 (d) Without this approval, Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. cannot be
42 paid for these critical services to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

43 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
44 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification No. 12 to
45 Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 with Maxim Healthcare Staffing Approval and
46 Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2024, be adopted after a single reading.

47 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
