AN ACT

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955, to repeal the requirement that the Board of Elections divide the District into voting precincts every five years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Election Precinct Modernization Temporary Amendment Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Election Code of 1955, approved August 12, 1955 (69 Stat. 669; D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.01 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

(a) Section 5(a)(8) D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.05(a)(8) is repealed.

Sec. 3. Applicability.

This act shall apply as of the effective date of Election Precinct Modernization Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, effective {INSERT DATE}, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-0056; 70 DCR 3809).

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved

29 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

30 Sec. 5. Effective date.

31 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of  
32 veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional  
33 review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
34 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the  
35 District of Columbia Register.

36 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
