• Ella Creech Peete Memorial Recognition Resolution of 2024

Ms. Peete was a longtime resident and community activist in Washington, D.C. She was an active participant during the Civil Rights Movement and a strong advocate for Black business owners in the District. She was one of the founders of the Black Chamber of Commerce in the District. She was also rose to become of the first Black managers at the Marriott Corporation before becoming Vice President of Horton's Funeral Service, which grew into one of the most successful businesses on the East Coast. Ms. Peete also played an active role in DC politics for decades, serving as President of the local chapter of the National Federation of Democratic Women, precinct captain, elected member of the DC Democratic State Committee and delegate to the Democratic National Convention.
