28	(b) Subparagraph (A)(i)(II) is amended by striking the semicolon and inserting the
29	phrase "annually with the fee for 2024 due by April 1, 2024; except, that an on-premises retailer
30	licensee, class C/T, D/T, C/N, or D/N, or a manufacturer licensee class B, shall pay the fee for
31	2024 by September 30, 2024;" in its place.
