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9 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
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12 To symbolically designate, on a temporary basis, the portion of the public alley system within Square  
13 0179 abutting Lot 111, as Annie’s Way and to repeal the previous designation of Annie’s Way.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may  
15 be cited as the “Annie’s Way Designation Temporary Act of 2024”.

16 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition  
17 Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-  
18 204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the portion of the public alley system within  
19 Square 0179 abutting Lot 111, as “Annie’s Way”.

20 Sec. 3. The Annie’s Way Designation Act of 2014, effective April 30, 2014 (D.C. Law 20-99; 61  
21 DCR 1594), is repealed.

22 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

23 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
24 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16,  
25 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

26 Sec. 5. Effective date.

27 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
28 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 60-day period of congressional review as provided

29 in section 602(c)(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat.  
30 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(2)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.

31 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
