25	act may be cited as the "Protecting Adjacent and Adjoining Property Owners from Construction
26	Damage Congressional Emergency Amendment Act of 2024".
27	Sec. 2. Section 6a(a)(2A)(B) of the Construction Codes Approval and Amendments Act
28	of 1986, effective April 20, 1999 (D.C. Law 12-261; D.C. Official Code § 6-1405.01(a)(2A)(B)),
29	is amended to read as follows:
30	"(B) The following permits shall require insurance pursuant to
31	subparagraph (A) of this paragraph; provided, that the requirements shall only apply to permits
32	issued 30 days after the adoption of emergency or final rules issued by the Mayor pursuant to
33	subparagraph (E) of this paragraph:
34	"(i) An addition, alteration, and repair permit pursuant to which the
35	applicant will be engaging in underpinning, construction at the property line or on the party wall

36	of an adjacent or adjoining property, or any construction activity for which a permit listed under
37	subsubparagraph (iii), (iv), (vi), (vii), or (viii) of this subparagraph would otherwise be

39	"(ii) An alteration and repair permit pursuant to which the
40	applicant will be engaging in underpinning, construction at the property line or on the party wall
41	of an adjacent or adjoining property, or any construction activity for which a permit listed under
42	subsubparagraph (iii), (iv), (vi), (vii), or (viii) of this subparagraph would otherwise be
43	required;
44	"(iii) A foundation permit;
45	"(iv) A demolition permit;
46	"(v) An excavation permit;
47	"(vi) A new building permit;
48	"(vii) A raze permit; and
49	"(viii) A sheeting and shoring permit.".

55	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
56	Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
57	90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
58	412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
59	D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
