27	enforcement procedures with those provided in Title 25 of the District of Columbia Official
28	Code, and to clarify that the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board has the authority to
29 30	issue cease-and-desist orders mandating compliance with the provisions of the Medical
31	Cannabis Program; and to amend the Medical Cannabis Amendment Act of 2022 to clarify
32	that the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board has authority to enforce against
