In February 2024, the Council enacted the Medical Cannabis License Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, effective February 22, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-403; 71 DCR 2101), ("emergency legislation") and the Medical Cannabis License Clarification Temporary Amendment Act of 2024, passed on 2nd reading on March 5, 2024 (Enrolled version Bill 25-679), ("temporary legislation"). The emergency legislation expires on May 22, 2024. The temporary legislation must still complete the 30-day review period required by section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and will not become law until after the emergency legislation has expired.

It is necessary that the provisions of the emergency legislation continue in effect, without interruption, until the temporary legislation is in effect.
