RE: Request to Place Measures on the Agenda for the June 25, 2024 Legislative Meeting
DATE: June 20, 2024

I request that the following measures be placed on the agenda for the June 25, 2024 Legislative Meeting:

- **Virtual Open Meetings Authority Extension Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024**
- **Virtual Open Meetings Authority Extension Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2024**

On April 2, 2024, the Council passed the Virtual Open Meetings Authority Extension Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, effective April 15, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-442; 71 DCR 4621) (“emergency act”), which expires July 14, 2024. On May 7, 2024 the Council passed the Virtual Open Meetings Authority Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2024, enacted May 29, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-482; 71 DCR 6752) (“temporary act”). The temporary act is currently undergoing congressional review and has a projected law date of August 1, 2024. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

- **Special Education for Young Adults in the Custody of the Department of Corrections Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024**
- **Special Education for Young Adults in the Custody of the Department of Corrections Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2024**

On April 2, 2024, the Council passed the Special Education for Young Adults in the Custody of the Department of Corrections Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, effective April 15, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-446; 71 DCR 4635) (“emergency act”), which expires July 14, 2024. On May 7, 2024, the Council also passed the Special Education for Young Adults in the Custody of the Department of Corrections Temporary Amendment Act of 2024, enacted April 15, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-485; 71 DCR 6760) (“temporary act”). The temporary act is currently undergoing congressional review and has a projected law date of December 6, 2024. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
