On Wednesday, June 26, 2024, Councilmember Brianne K. Nadeau, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Works and Operations, will convene a public roundtable to conduct oversight on the sexual harassment investigation report, as required by A25-0202, the Sexual Harassment Investigation Review Emergency Act. The legislation required the Office of the Inspector General to contract with an independent counsel to review the prior Mayor's Office of Legal Counsel Sexual Harassment Officer's investigations, review anything outside the scope of the prior investigations, and make recommendations on the government's sexual harassment complaint and investigation process. The legislation's final requirement directed the OIG to deliver the independent counsel's report to the Mayor and the Council. The roundtable will include discussions on the findings and conclusions presented, the contract execution and deliverables, and the report's recommendations on improving the sexual harassment process for District employees.

The roundtable will have a hybrid format, with government and invited public witnesses appearing in person. This roundtable will not be open to the public to testify.
