A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve a corrected version of the compensation and working conditions collective bargaining agreement for employees of the District of Columbia Public Schools who are represented by the Washington Teachers' Union, Local #6 of the American Federation of Teachers.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Corrected Compensation and Working Conditions Agreement between the District of Columbia Public Schools and the Washington Teachers' Union, Local #6 of the American Federation of Teachers Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024".

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve a corrected version of the negotiated compensation agreement previously submitted by the Mayor and approved by the Council for employees of the District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") who are represented by the Washington Teachers' Union, Local #6 ("WTU").

(b) The District of Columbia negotiated a compensation and working conditions agreement ("negotiated agreement") for certain DCPS employees that was approved by the Council on February 7, 2023, through the Compensation and Working Conditions Agreement between the District of Columbia Public Schools and the Washington Teachers' Union, Local #6

36 (c) The version of the agreement transmitted to and approved by the Council included a
37 drafting error. Specifically, section 36.10.2 of that version of the agreement stated that “[t]he
38 Parties agree to discuss additional compensation options for elementary Grade Level Chairs.”
39 However, DCPS and WTU had already agreed at that time that DCPS would provide a new
40 stipend of \$1,000 per year for elementary grade chairs starting in school year 2022 through
41 2023.” The updated stipend provision, however, was not included in the version of the
42 agreement submitted to the Council.

43 (d) To effectuate the intent and agreement of DCPS and WTU regarding the stipends, a
44 corrected version of the agreement, with a section 36.10.2 that states that “[a]ll elementary Grade
45 Level Chairs shall receive an annual non-pensionable stipend at \$1,000 starting in the 2022-2023
46 school year” must be approved by the Council.

47 (f) Failure to immediately approve the corrected version of the agreement may result in
48 undermining the confidence of union members in the District of Columbia government and may
49 jeopardize the future relationship between labor and management in the District of Columbia

50 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute
51 emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Corrected Compensation and Working
52 Conditions Agreement between the District of Columbia Public Schools and the Washington
53 Teachers’ Union, Local #6 of the American Federation of Teachers Emergency Approval
54 Resolution of 2024 be adopted on an emergency basis.

55 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
