16 To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve the proposed  
17 multiyear Contract No. PO-GF-2024-C-0001-NJH by and between the University of the  
18 District of Columbia and Ellucian Company LLC for continuation of software licensing,  
19 application hosting, and maintenance to support the University's Banner Enterprise  
20 Resource Planning system.

22 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
23 resolution may be cited as the "University of the District of Columbia Multiyear Contract No.  
24 PO-GF-2024-C-0001-NJH with Ellucian Company LLC Emergency Declaration Resolution of  
25 2024".

26 Sec. 2. (a) The University of the District of Columbia proposes to enter into a multiyear  
27 contract with Ellucian Company LLC for continuation of software licensing, application hosting,  
28 and maintenance to support the University's Banner Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system.

29 (b) The firm fixed price for the term of this multiyear contract with Ellucian Company  
30 LLC is \$3,181,429 for a 3-year period of performance.

31 (c) Without emergency Council approval the University will lose access to vital systems  
32 including student records, vendor and student payment, and class enrollment management.

33 (d) These critical technology services can only be obtained through the award of a  
34 multiyear contract with Ellucian Company LLC, which owns Banner.

35           Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
36 enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the  
37 "University of the District of Columbia Multiyear Contract No. PO-GF-2024-C-0001-NJH with  
38 Ellucian Company LLC Emergency Approval Resolution of 2024" be adopted on an emergency  
39 basis.

40           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
