30	Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024".
31	Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification No. 1 to
32	Contract No. NFPHC-MS-23-C-00054 ("Contract") between the Not-for-Profit Hospital
33	Corporation ("Hospital") and Northrium Health LLC, for the provision of anesthesia and
34	vascular access services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be
35	received under this Contract.

36	(b) The Base Year agreement was approved by Council in the amount of
37	\$1,810,430.96 for the period of August 1, 2023 through July 31, 2024 (CA25-327).
38	(c) With services winding-down at the hospital, it is taking an extended period of
39	time to negotiate financial terms with vendors to meet the hospital's staffing needs,
40	especially in light of nationwide and regional shortages in health professional services.
41	(d) UMC exercised eight months of option year 1 (August 1, 2024 – March 31,
42	2025) for \$1,025,910.99 to ensure uninterrupted anesthesia and vascular access services.
43	(e) If Proposed Modification 1 is approved, the aggregate value will exceed \$1
44	million in a 12-month period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.
45	(f) Without this approval, Northrium Health LLC cannot be paid for these
46	critical services provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.
47	Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
48	constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification No. 1 to
49	Contract NFPHC-MS-23-C-00054 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and
50	Northrium Health LLC. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2024,
51	be adopted after a single reading.
