22	resolution may be cited as the "Foreclosure Moratorium and Homeowner Assistance Fund
23	Coordination Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024".
24	Sec. 2. (a) On June 25, 2024, the Council passed the Foreclosure Moratorium and
25	Homeowner Assistance Fund Coordination Emergency Amendment Act of 2024 (D.C. Act 25-
26	514; 71 DCR 9340), which was enacted on July 18, 2024, and expires on October 16, 2024.
27	(b) On July 9, 2024, the Council passed a corresponding Foreclosure Moratorium and
28	Homeowner Assistance Fund Coordination Temporary Amendment Act of 2024 (D.C. Act 25-
29	533; 71 DCR 9942), which was transmitted to Congress on August 6, 2024, and is projected to
30	become law on December 7, 2024.
31	(c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
32	expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Foreclosure Moratorium and Homeowner Assistance Fund Coordination Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2024 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
