On Wednesday, November 13, 2024, Councilmember Matt Frumin will hold a public roundtable to discuss matters pertaining to the permitting, access, use, and capacity of athletic fields owned by the District. Subjects for discussion include how DPR manages its inventory of athletic fields for those who want a permit for use, as well as how they factor into the overall inventory of athletic fields in the District. **This roundtable is open to the public.**

The Subcommittee on Recreation and Community Affairs has oversight of the Department of Parks and Recreation and Chairman Frumin intends to bring both Council and public attention to DPR's programming and management of its recreational facilities. This roundtable will also allow the Department of Parks and Recreation to update District residents on the status of athletic fields across the District, their use, and the ability of the public to access them.

The Committee invites the public to testify. Those who wish to do so must register using the Council's Hearing Management System at <https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings> by **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 7**. All public witnesses who wish to provide oral testimony, including

those who represent organizations, will have 3 minutes to speak. Those witnesses who want to submit written testimony are also invited to do so. **Witnesses may testify in person or virtually**; witnesses should specify which option they are electing at the time they sign up to testify. The record will close at 5:00pm on November 20, 2024.

Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or who require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible, but no later than 5 business days before the proceeding. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although alternatives may be offered. Requests may be submitted via the Hearing Management System during registration or by contacting Mr. Joseph Dweck, Legislative Assistant to the Subcommittee on Recreation and Community Affairs, at (202) 727-7903 or via e-mail at jdweck@dccouncil.gov. It may not be possible to fulfill requests received less than 5 business days before the proceeding.
