22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23	act may be cited as the "Closing of a Public Alley in Square 3701, S.O. 23-06220, Congressional
24	Review Emergency Act of 2024".
25	Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 404 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
26	December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 787; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.04), and consistent with the Street
27	and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law
28	4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-201.01 et seq.), the Council finds that the portion of public alley in
29	Square 5051, as shown on the Surveyor's plat filed under S.O. 21-00136, is unnecessary for alley
30	purposes and orders it closed with title to the land to vest as shown on the Surveyor's plat.
31	(b) The ordering of this alley closing is contingent upon the property owner receiving the
32	requisite public space approvals for parking and loading access prior to the recordation of the
33	plat by the Surveyor.

Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
