A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification 2 to Contract No. NFPHC-ER-23-C between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), for the provision emergency department services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification 2 to Contract No. NFPHC-ER-23-C between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification 2 to Contract No. NFPHC-ER-23-C (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), for the provision emergency department services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

37 (b) The Council approved the base year on December 6, 2022 as A24-718.

38 (c) The Council approved option year 1 (Modification 1) on November 7, 2023,
39 as A25-0298.

40 (d) Despite a timely start to negotiations, reaching mutual agreement took longer
41 than expected – a frequent experience for UMC as the closure nears. The additional time
42 needed to finalize the clinical and financial terms caused Modification 2’s retroactive
43 status.

44 (e) If proposed Modification 2 to Contract No. NFPHC-ER-23-C (October 1,
45 2023 to March 31, 2025) is approved, the partial exercise of option year 2 for
46 \$3,497,908.26 would have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 6-month
47 period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.

48 (f) Without this approval, George Washington University Medical Faculty
49 Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), cannot be paid for the critical services provided and to be
50 provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

51 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
52 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Modification 2 to Contract
53 No. NFPHC-ER-23-C between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and George
54 Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”), Approval and
55 Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, be adopted after a single
56 reading.

57 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
