IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 13 and 14 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”) and Amergis Healthcare Staffing Inc. (formerly Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services Inc.) for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services (“Contract”), and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 13 and 14 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 between Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Amergis Healthcare Staffing Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2024”.

Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 13 and 14 to Contract NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Amergis Healthcare Staffing Inc.
