22	Sec. 2. Section 110 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, approved
23	October 21, 1968 (82 Stat. 1209; D.C. Official Code § 2-510), is amended as follows:
24	(a) Subsection (a)(1) is amended by striking the phrase "So far as necessary" and
25	inserting the phrase "Subject to subsection (c) of this section and so far as necessary" in its place.
26	(b) A new subsection (c) is added to read as follows:
27	"(c) In reviewing an order or decision of the Mayor or an agency in any court or
28	administrative proceeding, including but not limited to proceedings under subsection (a) of this
29	section, the reviewing tribunal shall defer to the Mayor or agency's reasonable interpretation of a
30	statute or regulation it administers, provided that the interpretation is not plainly wrong, or
31	inconsistent with the statutory or regulatory language or the legislature's intent.".
