On Thursday, December 12, 2024, at 1:30 PM, At-Large Councilmember Anita Bonds will convene a public roundtable to address labor relations in the District of Columbia. The purpose of the public roundtable is to provide a platform for unionized labor to share preexisting and prospective challenges affecting union membership.

The Committee of Executive Administration and Labor invites members of labor unions, the public, and other stakeholders to participate in a critical conversation on the current state of labor and workforce issues in the District. The District's labor force is integral to the District's economic recovery and ongoing development. As the District prepares for a transition into a new Presidential administration, the Committee recognizes the importance of understanding the perspective and priorities of unions and workers.

The goal of this roundtable is to garner a deeper understanding of work conditions, collective bargaining, negotiation litigation, and other labor concerns to help inform dialogues pertaining to the District's workplaces and labor rights.

Persons who wish to testify must register using the Council's Hearing Management System at https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings or phone the Committee at (202) 724-8198, at least by Tuesday, December 10, 2024, two business days before the hearing. Each witness will receive an individual Zoom invitation for the hearing in a separate e-mail. Witnesses are encouraged to submit an electronic version of their testimony. Testimony should be submitted through the Council's Hearing Management System at https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings in advance of the hearing. Oral testimony will be limited to 5 minutes for those testifying on behalf of an organization and 3 minutes for those testifying on behalf of themselves.

Witnesses who anticipate needing language interpretation or require sign language interpretation are encouraged to inform the Committee of the need as soon as possible before the proceeding. The Committee will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, otherwise, alternatives may be offered.

If someone is unable to testify at the public hearing, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record. Written statements should be submitted through the Hearing Management System at https://lims.dccouncil.gov/hearings or mailed to the Committee on Executive Administration and Labor, John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Suite 116, Washington, D.C. 20004. The record will close at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 30, 2024.
